Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 5 and 6 will be visiting Tring Natural History Museum on **Monday 20th May** as part of the Darwin's Delights topic.

The children will take part in a workshop called Adaptation where they will uncover species adaptations, explore oddities and generate species' future adaptations to help them to survive! They will also have to closely observe the specimens on display to complete the 'Darwin and the Voyage of the Beagle' activity.

The children will need to be in school at the normal time and will return to school before the end of the school day. The coach will be leaving school at 09:15 and will return to school at 15:00. The children will need to wear their **normal school uniform**. There is no need to bring any money as we will not be visiting the museum's gift shop.

Packed Lunch
