<u>English</u>	<u>Maths</u>
<p>In English, we'll be writing newspaper articles based on the events which have happened in our class novel: 'The Iron Man'.</p> <p>We will also be writing diary entries from the perspective of different characters in this book.</p>	<p>In Maths, Mrs Crawley/Mrs Brakefield and Mr Brooks will be looking at fractions, measurement (length, mass and capacity) and properties of shapes (including angles and symmetry).</p> <p>Miss Allsopp's class will be looking at fractions, measurement, properties of shapes and statistics.</p>
<u>Hook Day</u>	
<p>As part of their Hook Day, on Monday 4th November, the children will be introduced to characters from their new class book and will be creating artwork based around this. The children will not need to bring anything for this Hook Day. There will be plenty of surprises awaiting the children on the day.</p>	
<u>Topic</u>	
<p>Year 3-4's next topic is called 'Mighty Metals'. In this topic children will build on their understanding of the properties of different materials and will learn about visible and invisible forces. They will explore the scientific world of forces and magnetism, metals and materials. By gaining a deep understanding of these scientific areas, children will finally create a game by testing, trialling, making and predicting.</p>	
<u>Science</u>	<u>Other subjects</u>
<p>In Science, we will be looking at being able to use and create our own classification keys to sort a variety of species. We will consider unusual features in order to determine differences between plants found living in Antarctica. We will design our own plant that could survive in the harsh and unforgiving lands.</p>	<p>PE - Year 3-4 will have Coach Jenner, who will be teaching them basketball skills. They will also be developing their hockey skills with Mr Anderson.</p> <p>French- Y3-developing our understanding of common French phrases used in conversations and counting numbers up to 60.</p>
<u>RE and PSHE</u>	
<p>RE - our next topic in RE will be looking at 'promises' with a focus on the story of Noah.</p> <p>PSHE - our next unit will be looking at 'celebrating differences'.</p>	<p>Y4- learning the days of the week and looking at how to describe the weather.</p> <p>Art - Year 3-4 will be learning how to make patterns using magnets!</p>
