Dear Parents/Carers,

In the Summer Term we will be running a school trip for all Foundation children to **Aylesbury Waterside Theatre** to watch '*The Tiger Who Came to Tea*'. This will be a great opportunity for us to see some real theatre which is an experience some may have missed out on during the pandemic. The story is a childhood classic and we hope the children will really love this experience!

The visit will take place on **Friday 1<sup>st</sup> July** where the children will be picked up from school by coach at 11.00am and returned to school at 1.30pm. The children will have their booked school lunch, or pack lunch if you prefer, once they return to school at 1.30pm so please ensure you have booked this on the ParentPay system as normal. Pick up will be as usual at 3.25pm from the Foundation playground. The children do not need to bring anything with them on the trip as they will have their snack time as normal before we depart and lunch once we get back to school. Please ensure your child wears full school uniform.

To be able to run this trip safely, we require some parent volunteers. If you would like to volunteer to help with this trip, please email the school office **by Friday 10<sup>th</sup> June**. If we have an overwhelming response, **we shall draw names out of a hat and we will contact you only if you have been chosen.**

In order to cover the cost of transporting your child to and from the Theatre and the cost of their ticket we ask for a **voluntary contribution of £15.00 per child to be paid by Friday 10<sup>th</sup> June**. Please pay via your ParentPay account selecting 'Foundation @ Waterside Theatre' payment item. We do not require your consent for your child to participate in this school trip as you will have already done that when submitting your Google form, 'Consent Form for School Trips and other Off-Site Activities 2021-22' back in September 2021.
