Filmmaking - Years 1-6 - Monday 3.30-4.30pm

Joanna from Milton Keynes Filmmaking Club has been successfully running this club at High Ash for a few years now. We are pleased to confirm that she will continue with this club next term. Get ready for lights, camera, action! Enhance literacy, boost confidence, and foster teamwork by producing short films using tools like a clapperboard, green screen, and Canon EOS R50.

Street Jazz Dance with Eve - Years 1-6 - Monday 3.30-4.30pm

Street Dance with Eve is very popular among the children. We are pleased to confirm she will continue with this club next term.

Supersports Club with Ross Neary - Autumn term: Football/TAG Rugby Skills (Tues and Thurs)

Ross Neary will continue to offer two sports clubs, for Year 4-6 on a Tuesday and Years 1 to 3 on Thursday which he will continue to in our next academic year. There will be different sports activities each term and the clubs will be tailored to the skills and abilities of the group.
